Daylight Savings Time ends next Lord's Day. Remember to set your clocks back one hour on Saturday evening.

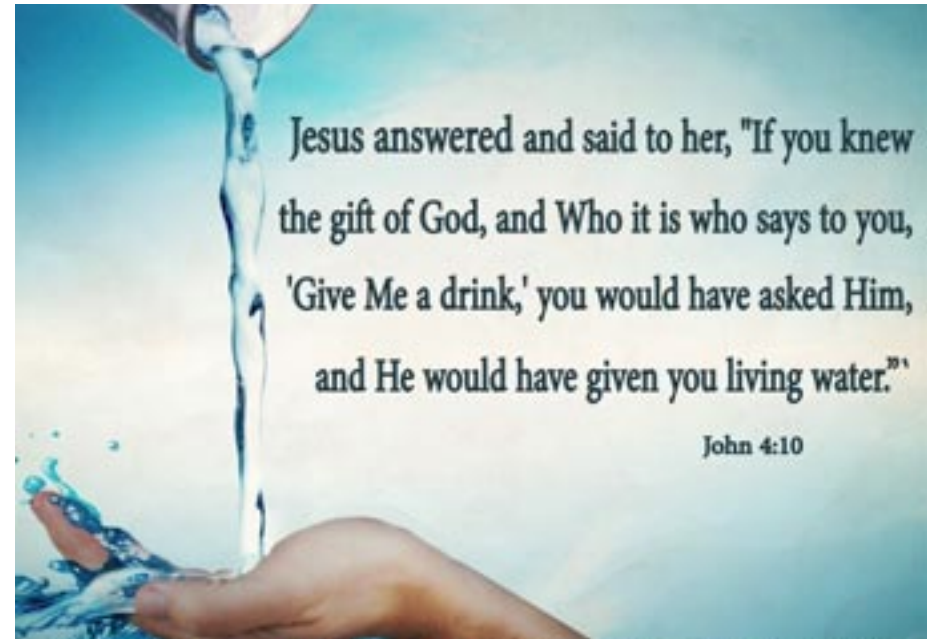
